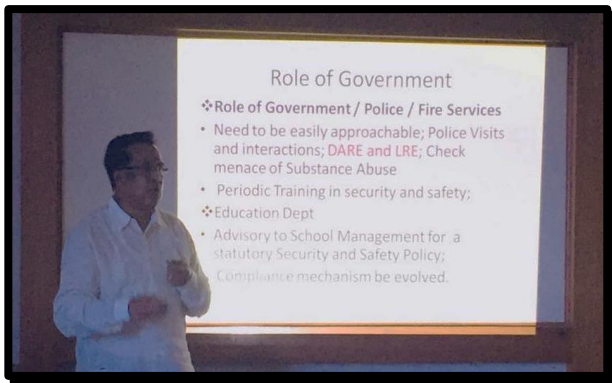


Workshop On Safety in Schools and Dealing with High Risk Behaviours
