To sneak a look into the Scientific Past, students of classes III-V visited *The Nehru Planetarium*, situated on the grounds of Teen Murti Bhavan, officially known as '**Nehru Memorial Museum and Library**', the erstwhile residence of First Prime Minister of India, Jawaharlal Nehru.
